

NOISE management

Along with most live music venues across the country, from time to time we receive complaints about noise arising from functions within the hall.

The trustees, following consultation with the local council and an acoustic engineer have embarked upon an extensive program of hall modifications to both support live music on site and limit the impact of noise on local residents.
